1. Executive Summary

This report presents an evaluation of the parent and carer feedback gathered for Dewstow Primary School in June 2026. The evaluation focuses on core dimensions of school operational success, including culture, pupil well-being, communication, and learning quality.

CRITICAL CONTEXT NOTE: A total of seven (7) parents/carers responded to this iteration of the survey. Due to this exceptionally small sample size, each individual response accounts for approximately 14.3% of the total metrics. Consequently, the statistical outputs within this report must be interpreted as a qualitative focus group snapshot rather than a generalised representation of the entire parent body.

2. Strategic Key Findings

Areas of Excellence (100% Unanimous Agreement)

- **Pupil Safety and Well-being:** All 7 respondents strongly agree/agree that their children feel entirely secure, supported, and happy under the school's care.
- **Inclusive Environment:** The school atmosphere is perceived as highly welcoming, warm, and community-centric.
- **Leadership Approachability:** Parents note that teachers and school leaders are highly accessible and responsive to inquiries.

Areas for Target Improvement & Monitoring

- **Academic Progress Visibility:** A slight variance was observed regarding the depth and frequency of updates provided regarding children's academic milestones.
- **Extracurricular Provision:** A minor subset of respondents expressed an appetite for a broader variety of after-school clubs and enrichment programs.

3. Detailed Analysis by Category

A. School Culture & Pupil Well-being

The feedback strongly confirms that Dewstow Primary maintains an exceptionally positive, safe, and fair environment. Pupil welfare continues to be the school's hallmark. Behaviour management framework metrics indicate an overwhelmingly orderly and settled learning atmosphere.

B. Communication & Parental Engagement

While interaction with staff is highly rated for its warmth and open-door accessibility, there is scope to institutionalise more systematic progress updates. When individual issues are escalated, parents express high confidence that leadership listens and executes rapid resolutions.

C. Learning & Enrichment

The overall standard of teaching is well-regarded, and homework loads are evaluated as balanced and manageable. To elevate parental satisfaction further, school management should review expanding post-school activity frameworks.
